

Steps Flip Out Productions has taken to ensure sanitization to ensure safety.

- **Cleaning:** Flip Out Productions has partnered with a Professional Cleaning & Disinfecting Service that uses antimicrobial technology that constantly combats germs and viruses, including Covid-19, for a minimum of 90 days. This service goes above and beyond CDC guidelines for infection control and safety, providing highly advanced cleaning to prevent the spread of Coronavirus, COVID-19 and other viruses



How It Works: When applied to a surface or incorporated into a material, it forms a covalent bond with the substrate and creates a microbiostatic antimicrobial coating. The coating forms a nano-bed shield of spikes (self assembling monolayer), each of which carry a positive charge that attracts the negatively charged bacteria. Once attracted, the molecular spikes pierce the cell and rupture its cell membrane, causing that bacterial microorganism to die.

This Antimicrobial protection is applied to all surfaces both hard and soft, has no harmful residues, is food-safe, dye and fragrance free, EPA registered, and FDA compliant.

In addition, coaches will be regularly disinfecting equipment, sink and bathroom areas, light switches, door knobs, hand railings, and common areas throughout the day. A deep-clean will be performed after all programming.



Prioritizing health and safety for your child at camp!

We are following CDC Guidelines for Camps, Cleaning Guidelines, with some additional Flip Out Safety Practices

- **Limited Group Sizes:** Complying with CDC Guidelines small groups of campers will stay together all day, each day. Outdoor activities will be prioritized including games, gymnastics, lunch & snack time, and water play when weather permits. Groups will be spaced out and rotated through level 1, level 2, and outside spaces during the day.
- **Drop Off / Pick Up:** Parents will have the option of dropping off & picking up curbside or outside in our courtyard. Staff will be sanitizing hands upon arrival.

Due to limited staff, precare and aftercare will not be offered at this time.

Rain or Inclement Weather Drop Off Plan: You may ring the doorbell and a coach will meet you at the door. Upon entering the building there will be a sanitation station that all are required to use before going to their designated area.

- **Daily Screening:**

Staff Screening: All staff members will have their temperature checked, and screened for health before entering the building daily.

Flip Out Productions requires that all parents screen their child before drop off. This includes daily temperature-checks, reviewing Covid-19 Symptoms.

Please keep campers home if they are showing any signs of illness. Parents will be contacted immediately if campers show any signs of illness or injury. Campers will be comfortably quarantined until their parents/guardians are able to pick them up.

Keep in mind, campers will be physically active all day! Check the list below for what to expect.



Normal After Camp Effects to Expect:

- **Fatigue** - Many campers will take a long nap!
- **Muscle Soreness** - We are working hard in the gym & outside! (legs, arms, abs, shoulders, back)
- **Increased Appetite**
- **Hand soreness** - swinging on bars, ropes, and rings
- **Headache** - We encourage campers to drink plenty of water during the camp day, however increased activity and outside time can increase the risk of dehydration.

- **Activities:** Games will be modified to limit physical contact. Gym equipment will be cleaned between group rotations.

Coaches will be wearing gloves and face masks when spotting athletes. Spotting by coaches will only be used when necessary.

- **Masks / Face Coverings:** Staff will wear masks at all times. We ask that parents wear masks during drop off and pick up. Campers will not be required to wear masks, however we will respect and empower any camper that wishes to wear one.

- **Floor Markings and Signage:** We will mark off safe distances throughout the gym to help keep children appropriately spaced.

Each camper will have their own designated cubby, dot, seating area per event, snack & lunchtime table seat.

CDC Guidelines for handwashing, social distancing, and safe sneezing will be taught & posted throughout the facility.

- **Hygiene:** Scheduled handwashing breaks will be built into each group's schedule. Hand sanitizer stations will be placed throughout the gym for use.

Flip Out Productions will provide supplies including antibacterial soap, 5 hand sanitation stations throughout the building, posted CDC sanitizing signage, 2 sinks for handwashing with soap.

Coaches will have liquid sanitizing spray on hand for immediate use.

We will utilize open windows, fans, and air conditioning to maximize fresh air circulation in the gym, per CDC Guidelines.
